SCHOOL DATA SYSTEM - TRANSFER BEGINS NEXT WEEK



Over the next week, we will be moving from the Scholarpack data management system to its sister company, Arbor.

Arbor is a more complete data system, which will allow us to move away from ParentPay in future and to offer debit card payments, as well as the ability to pre-book breakfast and after-school clubs.

With the move from Scholarpack, we will also be switching to the Arbor parent app.

The new app includes all the things the current Scholarpack Parents App has but will also allow parents to make progress evening bookings, check a live calendar and access newsletters and reports. This should mean that we can bring many more of the day-to-day communication functions into a central system.

Details of how to connect to this will be sent out after the data transfer. Whilst we get it set up and parents enrolled, we will continue using the Jotter App and SMS messaging to stay in touch.

As part of the data transfer, we will ask parents to complete updated consents this term, covering everything from communication preferences to photography in school and the giving of calpol.
